The committee will conduct workshops on topics related to the narratives presented by persons of color on their histories and cultures. The committee will also provide awareness to help unlearn norms perpetuating subconscious self-hate. The committee will supplement academic instruction via tutoring and workshops.

PUBLIC RELATIONS TEAM

Committee Expectations: The work of the committee includes spreading the vision and mission of P-CoC to the general public and recruiting volunteers to join the P-CoC family. The committee will also serve as an in-house resource to individuals needing services from P-CoC.
