ANDREA DEVARIE

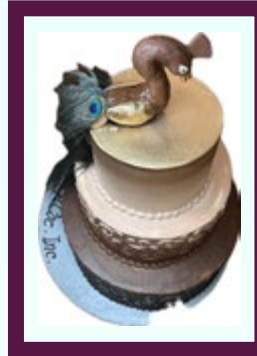
