

NATIONAL HISPANIC HERITAGE MONTH

National Hispanic Heritage Month

Sept. 15 – Oct. 15

Originally marking the dates in September during which countries in Central or South America gained their independence from Spain, it was originally signed into law as Hispanic Heritage Week in 1968.

Today we celebrate the contributions of American citizens whose ancestors came from Spain, Mexico, the Caribbean and Central and South America. The diversity of cultural heritage and their distribution across the U.S. lead to localized forms of acknowledgement.

Several current White House Cabinet members claim heritage from the Americas and Caribbean. Here's a few other Americans with heritage from Mexico and Central America:



Ellen Ochoa (Mexican heritage)

In 1993 Ellen Ochoa had the distinction of becoming the first Hispanic American woman to go to space on board the Space Shuttle Discovery on a mission to study the Earth's ozone layer. Ochoa completed three more missions. She became the first Hispanic American director of the Johnson Space Center in 2013. After retiring with 30 years of service she continues to encourage women to pursue careers in STEM. In her words, "I think we need all the best and brightest people working in science and engineering fields, and that is certainly not limited to men or white men or anything like that,"



Cristina Henríquez

A New York Times Best selling author, Cristina Henríquez has written a collection of stories, novels, and regularly speaks to aspiring writers about the writer's creative and technical process. Cristina who grew up half-American, half-Panamanian, speaks about identity writes about the struggles immigration. A gifted writer with a great talent for creating powerful character portraits Cristina is also author of novel titled Book of Unknown Americans which has been called, "a flawlessly written book about immigration," , Henríquez currently teaches at Northwestern University



Luis von Ahn

This pioneer of crowd sourcing is a Guatemalan-born American. Luis von Ahn is responsible for two significant contributions to technology. The CAPTCHA system is used almost every time you sign into a new website as those "I am not a robot" interface before accessing certain pages. LuisHe is also the co-founder of Duolingo, a completely free app that has revolutionized language learning.
